As part of the annual Asian Competition Forum (ACF) conference events, we are holding, for the first time, a student essay competition.

Eligibility

All students currently enrolled at a University institution are invited to produce a written submission of 2500 words maximum (excluding footnotes) on the following topic that echoes the theme of the 2017 ACF conference to be held in Hong Kong later this year:

Essay Topic

The enforcement and implementation of competition law and policy in Asia is in reverse because of protectionist and nationalist pressures. Do you agree?

Prize

The most creative, original and insightful essay, as judged by a panel of Competition Law academics, will be announced on the **30th November 2017** and the author will receive a prize of US\$500, a certificate acknowledging their achievement and the winning essay will be posted on the ACF website.

Submission of entries

All essay submission must be submitted by the **1st November 2017** in accordance with the terms and conditions below.

Terms and Conditions

1. All submissions must be the original work of a single individual.
2. Submissions must be sent to the Asian Competition Law Forum web site (www.asiancompetitionforum.com).
3. Submissions must arrive at the ACF website by 1200 AEST 1 November 2017.
4. This competition is open globally to all enrolled University Students. Proof of university enrollment will be required from the winner.
5. Submissions are to be completed in the English language, in a Word document, use 12-point font, 1.5-line spacing and must not exceed 2,500 words (not including footnotes which should not be excessively long).
6. Citation should follow the Oxford Standard for the Citation of Legal Authorities (OSCOLA) https://www.law.ox.ac.uk/sites/files/oxlaw/oscola_4th_edn_hart_2012quickreferenceguide.pdf
7. The author of the winning essay will receive a prize of US\$500, a certificate acknowledging their achievement and their winning essay will be posted on the ACF website.
8. The decision of the judges appointed by ACF is final.
