



Dr. Khin Khin Oo, Professor at the Department of Law, University of Yangon (Myanmar), received her LLB (1993), LLM (1997), and PhD in Law (2005) degrees from University of Yangon. Her teaching career has begun as tutor at Law Department of Dagon University in 1995; and afterwards she has been

teaching and researching at a number of Myanmar universities' law departments. Her area of specialization is civil law – particularly criminal law, family law, constitutional law and administrative law, corporate law and child rights. In 2004, she did part of her research for PhD degree at International Institute for the Rights of the Child (IDE) in Sion, Switzerland. She was a visiting research fellow at CALS, National University of Singapore (2014), at Seoul National University (2014), at Central European University (2016), and at Max Planck Institute for Comparative Public Law and International Law, Heidelberg, Germany (2017). Her current research interest is constitutional adjudication systems and judicial review of administrative acts of some different countries and different legal systems. She has been involving as drafting member of Myanmar Technical and Vocational Education and Training Law since 2016, and drafting member of National Water Resource Committee Law and National Water Law. She is one of the members of Research Group on Constitutionalism in Asia since 2016. She has been acting as core member of International Cooperation Office of University of Yangon since 2018 December. In 2019 June, she was appointed as one of the members of Union Legal Aid Board of the Republic of the Union of Myanmar.
